On April 22, 2018, at approximately 1430 hours, the Crook County Sheriff's Office received a report of a missing person in the Millican OHV area. The investigation revealed that Terry Gore, who is a 53 year old male, had been missing since approximately 0730 hours on April 22, 2018. Terry and his girlfriend had been camping in the area. Terry had left camp and went for a walk with his girlfriend. Terry's girlfriend went back to the vehicle when she became tired. After about seven hours, Terry's girlfriend was still at their campsite waiting for Terry's return when she was contacted by two citizens.

One of the citizens called the Crook County Sheriff's Office to report the missing person. The Crook County Sheriff's Office deployed the Search and Rescue team in an attempt to locate Terry. After about one hour of searching, Terry was located by a different citizen about one mile north of his campsite. Terry was conscious and alert, but complaining of dehydration and muscle soreness.

Terry was given a ride to his campsite where he was reunited with his girlfriend.

The Crook County Sheriff's Office would like everyone to enjoy recreating in Crook County, but would like to remind everyone to let people know where you are going and pack appropriate supplies and clothing with you.
